NSW DISASTER RECOVERY PROGRAM at the Ulladulla Civic Centre (UCC)

The NSW Disaster Recovery Program is now fully operational in the Ulladulla Civic Centre (in the auditorium to the right of the Library).

Support services are available from State and Federal Government bodies, as well as private organisations and charities. Feedback from a Conjola resident on the process and the availability of services is extremely positive.

Upon registering yourself with the Program at the front desks (bit like checking in to a hotel - without the need for a credit card) you will have access to representatives from the following support services:-

Importantly, once you have registered with the Program your needs are supported throughout the whole of the recovery process. Cash is available and handed to you as needed, as well as advice on all manner of State/Commonwealth entitlements as rebates, exemptions and disaster funds.

There are already familiar Lake Conjola faces volunteering at the UCC representing Red Cross, Salvos and Vinnies.
